Hello Everyone,

We obviously hope everyone is well and taking what precautions they can to stay clear of viral infection. I want to update everyone on the status of the activities at Aquatic Park as of today.

The Center is essentially closed until at least March 23. As we get closer, we will re-evaluate pushing that date farther out. So here's where we are:

***All classes and programs are suspended until further notice;** this includes the Computer Lab and the exercise equipment.

***The newest information involves the congregate lunch program. Project Open Hand will only be providing food packaged to take home.** These meals can be picked-up at the main entrance between **11:00am – 11:30am**. Service in the dining room is discontinued until further notice.

***The Blue Room will not be available as a waiting area.**

***If you have an appointment to have your taxes completed by AARP Tax Assistance, we will be **continuing** that program.** Please come to the front door and we will direct you to the appropriate location in the building.

***Social work assistance and ADRC assistance will be available by telephone.**

We will try to keep everyone updated as this situation changes. In the meantime, below is a short message from our colleagues at the Well Connected program with ways to stay active and in contact during our closure. I've attached the two forms they mention to this email.
